- ✓ 'I have listened to a range of music and can identify features and concepts. I can give constructive comments on my own and other's work, including the work of professionals'

## - YOUR FESTIVAL AT YOUR SCHOOL

There will also be the possibility of receiving in-school workshops in the run-up to the festival. Musician and amateur DETTA DANFORD will be offering **half-day in school workshops** in the weeks preceding the festival, suitable for classes of up to 30 children who are all in the same or adjacent year groups.

Pupils will participate in workshops exploring and experiencing the core musical elements relating to the festival artists and their music. These themes will include 'Global Dance Rhythms', 'Chants and Drones' and 'Rituals in Music', utilising vocal, body and rhythm work, working with instrumentalists and classroom instruments where possible, time for group discussion and creatively focused tasks to come up with original musical material.
