TRIO FOR A GREEN PEA, created by French music maverick Pascal Ayerbe, has been performed over 250 times since its creation to thousands of children across the globe. It receives its UK premiere in Scotland as part of LOVE MUSIC FESTIVAL.

Born in Paris in 1976, **Pascal Ayerbe** calls himself “the sound scribbler”. He is a unique composer and musician, creating music from haphazard and clumsy strokes of inspiration.

On a set dominated by a large tree, three sound-gardening musicians create a zany collection of outrageously entertaining and quirky melodies. Discover a whimsical symphony where mandolin, accordion, bass clarinet, ukulele, banjo, bells, bird calls and bow saw join plastic toys and kitchen utensils to create an energetic, fun and charming theatre-concert.
