Members Discount Scheme

General

1. The scheme is operated by the Northern Pensioners Association Crewe and District, hereinafter referred to as the NPA .
2. Participation is open to all businesses (hereinafter referred to as Participants) operating in Crewe & Nantwich and the surrounding area.
3. The aim of the scheme is to encourage local businesses to offer a discount on their normal charges or prices to senior citizens and to encourage NPA members to patronise participants in the scheme.
4. The discount must be available to all NPA members over the minimum retirement age for women. Proof of age and evidence of membership of the NPA may be requested by the Participant at any time. Participants are free to introduce their own alternative form of identity such as a Discount Card.
5. Participants are free to offer the same discount to other senior citizens if they so wish.
6. On joining the scheme participants will be provided with a scheme sticker to display on their premises or vehicle. This sticker remains the property of the NPA and must be removed and returned to the NPA immediately on request.
7. Participants may leave the scheme at any time, in which case the sticker must be removed from their property and returned to the NPA.
8. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time

Retailers and Traders

Participants must offer a minimum of 10% discount on their prices for a minimum of one half day per week. Participants are free to offer greater discounts at any time if they wish.

Pubs/Restaurants/Cafes

Participants must offer menu choices specifically for senior citizens on at least one day per week
